

JAZZ COMP TEAM: Additional Fee Schedule for the Remainder of the Year



- Competition Costume Fee (Due with October Tuition) \$75.00
Black Split Sole Jazz Shoes (purchased through the studio, we recommend the slip on boot) will need to be worn to class and can also be used for performances and competitions. Please keep them in new condition by wearing street shoes to and from class and changing into your jazz shoes once you are in the building.
- Competition Fees \$80.00 (due with November Tuition)
- Recital Costume/Building Fee/DVD (\$25 due in January, \$25 due in February)

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS?????

Black Leotard, Black tights & Black Split Sole Jazz shoes (they can be the same ones they wear for competition as long as they are in “NEW” condition.) Minis need Tap shoes for class. It is **EXTREMELY IMPORTANT** that dancers are dressed in their appropriate dancewear for class each time! **NO Baggie clothes or PJ bottoms** should be worn to class. A uniform class helps the teacher check technique, body placement, precision and formations with ease.

Information on Competitions/Performances:

Competition and Performance Dates will be announced at a later date. Always check the website “Performance Team Information” page for newsletters, notes and competition updates. The competition/performance season begins the end of March and goes through June. We will perform at a Utah Jazz Basketball Game and we will also participate in 3 competitions. Tickets for spectators will need to be purchased to attend the Jazz Game Performance. We will receive a group discount off the face value of the tickets. More details will come later. Each family will be responsible for buying/selling 3 Jazz game tickets. Dancer’s tickets are included in their competition fees. Spectator admission will also be charged for competitions usually about \$5-7 dollars. Performer’s entrance and individual award are included in their competition fees.

We usually begin learning material for routines in November. Combined practices will be held to put the routine together about a month prior to our first performance. Your class time may change in order to practice with the other Jazz Comp classes.
