The dress rehearsal will be in the morning & early afternoon hours and the performance begins at 7:00 p.m.. All students must arrive at 6:30 p.m. so we can start on time. Some classes may be combined with another class for recital and have combined practices in June That information will be distributed this spring along with Dress Rehearsal Schedule.

All Students are expected to participate. The recital is a unique and rewarding experience for all! We encourage everyone to approach this milestone with enthusiasm and support. The benefits of participating in the artistic process of a rehearsal, choreography, teamwork and performing in front of a live audience are very valuable. Each student is given the opportunity to be someone special, someone who has worked diligently to achieve their goals. Performing on stage builds confidence and character and gives one a sense of accomplishment and pride.

CLASS & INDIVIDUAL PICTURES

A Professional Photographer will take individual and class pictures during dress rehearsal. You are welcome to video or take pictures at the dress rehearsal. We offer pictures & provide you with a video for your convenience. You can relax & enjoy the performance, and have something to remember it. No cameras will be allowed during the performance. To provide a positive environment for the students, we suggest the following for audience members:

- Please arrive early and be in your seat before the performance begins at 7:00. Student must arrive at 6:30.
- Please turn cellular phones off.
- No cameras of any kind will be allowed in the theater during performance. You may video the dress rehearsal.
- Best dress or nice casual dress is recommended.
- Please remain seated for the *entire* performance. Leaving early or coming in and out during the performance is inconsiderate to those around you and disruptive.
- Please refrain from calling out or yelling your child's name during the performance.
- Not recommended for children under age 3. If you must bring a young child, please secure tickets near the aisle.
- Many parents bring good luck gifts/flowers for students

RECITAL TICKETS

Tickets will go on sale through Weber State Ticket office approximately one month before the performance. More details will be distributed this spring. Tickets are assigned seating \$6.00. Tickets are sold on a first come first served basis and are assigned seating.

RECITAL COSTUME FEE

Each class will have a costume fee charged. A portion of this fee helps cover expenses associated with the rental of the facilities at Weber State, the staff required to run the stage, sound and lights. We take pride in providing high quality, practical, modest and affordable costumes.

We have not had an increase in Recital Fees since 2007. Due to recent raises in rent and costume costs, a slight increase is necessary. **NEW THIS YEAR...** Each family will receive a complimentary DVD of the performance! Additional DVDs are \$25.00 each. Please pick your DVD up in the office September of 2012 when fall classes start!

Half the costume payment is due with January Tuition
The remaining portion is due with February Tuition.

*Jazz & Hip Hop classes need black split-sole shoes. Ballet students need Pink Ballet Shoes. These can be the shoes they wear to class. (available in the office) Keep them looking new!

Students are measured in January & February. Costumes will be delivered in June. Costumes aren't rentals, they are yours to keep! Classes will be held through June until recital.

Studio Policy: Accounts must be paid in full, including June tuition, before costumes can be picked up. We have a no refund policy on tuition, costumes and all other fees.
