RECITAL COSTUMES

Costumes will be distributed after June 10th

during class. Costumes with account balances will be held in the office until payment is received in full. Once you receive your costume, try it on with parent supervision. Minor alterations are your responsibility, if it seems way too big or too small contact the office immediately! A "Recital Handbook" with important information on hair, make-up, parking, and other details will be in your costume packet.

Students need to supply the items listed below. Purchase these items ASAP in the office as our stock is limited and we may not have what you need in stock last minute!

- **Classical Ballet Classes** need Pink Ballet Shoes. New tights will be included in your costume.
- **Children's Dance Classes** will perform bare foot except the Children's Dance III Tues. 4:00 & Thur. 5:30 classes. They will wear their tap shoes with no socks.
- **Jazz Classes** need black split-sole shoes \$40 - \$50.00. Tights, leggings, or leg wear is with your costume.
- **Hip Hop Classes** including boys, need black split-sole shoes \$40 - \$50.00. Leg wear is with your costume.
- **Show-Time Dancers** need pink tights & ballet shoes.

Studio Policy: Accounts must be paid in full, including June tuition, before costumes can be picked up. No refunds on tuition, costumes and other fees. Checks are not accepted on account with balances over \$100, cash or credit please.

RECITAL TICKETS

Tickets go on sale through Weber State Ticket office Friday, June 1st. Tickets are assigned seating \$6.00 each. They are sold first come first serve. You can purchase advance tickets in person at the main ticket box office located at the Dee Events Center, online at weberstatetickets.com or over the phone 801-626-8500. Tickets online or over the phone require a \$6.00 handling fee. Weber State has no refunds.

RECITAL & CLASS PICTURES



We will be taking a snapshot of classes for the recital program during class June 18 - 23. Please do not miss class the week before recital!

Regular class attire should be worn.

Professional individual and class pictures will be taken in costume during dress rehearsal. Pictures will be available for purchase at the Dress Rehearsal and mailed home in July. The free DVD of the performance will be available in the office after Fall classes begin. You are welcome to video or take pictures at the dress rehearsal, but it is not allowed during the performance. We offer pictures & videos for your convenience. You can relax & enjoy the performance, and have something to remember it.

To provide a positive environment for the students, we suggest the following for etiquette for audience members:

- Arrive early, be in your seat before performance start time
- Please turn cellular phones and all electronic devices off.
- No cameras of any kind will be allowed in the theater during performance.
- Best dress is recommended.
- Please remain seated for the *entire* performance. Leaving early or coming in and out during the performance is inconsiderate to those around you and disruptive.
- Please refrain from calling out or yelling your child's name during the performance.
- Not recommended for children under age 3. If you must bring a young child, please sit near the aisle.
- Many parents bring good luck gifts/flowers for students
